

Field Marshall Responsibilities

Greeter: Introduce yourself to all teams and officials that arrive at the field. Make them aware of water, first aid, team shade tents, washrooms, and other services available at the field and headquarters.

Ensure that teams are aware that games will start on time and that they must do their warmup off field and be prepared to start immediately at the scheduled time. Let coaches and officials know that any questions or situations should be directed through you to solve or answer. If you are in need of assistance, you should use the communication system to contact Tournament Headquarters: Sue Wheaton: 426-9643(cell), Donna Brass 421-3756 (cell), Brian Pocha via walkie-talkie.

Team/fan Placement: Teams MUST locate on the opposite side of the field as the fans.

Informational Items: All of the following are available at Mount Baker Secondary...

- First aid
- Concession: drinks, food and raffles
- Team standings: especially important for round-robin divisions
- Team packages
- Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Discipline/protest committee (access to)

Field Preparation: For this tournament, this is your field for the weekend, you need to ensure that it is prepared for play and cleaned up after play. This includes ensuring parents have put up and taken down nets and corner flags for each day. As well, maintaining a clean field, free of garbage keeps an appearance that demands respect from others.

Game Results: For each game, collect a record of game results (game sheet) and yellow/red cards from each referee after the game. This information should be immediately relayed to Tournament Headquarters as they are keeping track of standings and infractions. Also please hand in team roster (if given one by coach) to tournament headquarters if not handed in at registration.

Game Equipment: Hand out and collect referee assistant flags for each game. Game balls for competitions are supplied by the competing teams. Set up nets each morning and take them down each night. Equipment will be handed out at registration on Friday night. Equipment will include 2 goal nets, 2 referee flags, a high visibility vest, a walkie-talkie, pen, and the game rosters for each team.

Disciplinary Committee: Any situations that arise please attempt to resolve them in consultation with the concerned parties. If there is a question re: protest, discipline, etc. contact Stew Daroux (417-9816), or Murray Vogt (426-9705).

Saturday Cleanup: Materials needed for Sunday morning should be delivered Saturday night to those individuals who will be starting the first shift on Sunday morning.

Clean up on Sunday afternoon: requires that all materials/equipment be brought to Mount Baker Senior Secondary gymnasium. Someone will be there to direct you.

Be sure to wear your orange vest, as people might need to seek you out. The person, who is relieving you, should find you and get an update plus all materials needed, including this information.
